Contingency Date

This year the exam boards have introduced, for the first time, a contingency date into the exam timetable. This will enable exams to be moved if they cannot take place on the scheduled day due to local or national emergencies.

This designated date is **Wednesday 26th June**.

The decision whether to invoke this contingency date rests solely with the exam boards. It is **not** a school contingency date and does not mean that if a student misses an exam for any reason they will be able to sit it on the 26th June.

Whilst the exams are all scheduled to finish before that date, parents are **strongly** advised to ensure students remain available for the 26th June in case the exam boards need to invoke the contingency plan during the exam season which, of course, we'll not know of until the need arises.

Obviously, we hope that this doesn't happen but having a date built into the timetable ensures students are able to complete exams which may be affected by outside events.
